Walnut Creek Police seeking information regarding July 11 shooting:

Man in custody, no injuries reported

The Walnut Creek Police Department is asking for the public's assistance regarding a report of a shot being fired by one person towards another on July 11, 2024, at 7:00 a.m. Patrol officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of South Main Street upon receiving a 911 call. The victim was not struck by gunfire and was not injured.

Detectives investigated the case originally as a suspicious circumstance, but have since classified this as an attempted homicide. On the evening of July 11, detectives located a Concord man believed to have been involved and took him into custody. He is being held at the Contra Costa County Jail in Martinez on charges of attempted homicide and being a convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

Detectives continue to follow up on additional leads at this time, and are asking anyone who might have any information relating to this incident to please call Walnut Creek Police at 925-943-5844. Police believe this was an isolated incident, and that no other people in the area were at risk.
