### **A WALNUT CREEK RESIDENT SUFFERING FROM A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS ARRIVES AT POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH A GUN**

On March 4th, at 12:45 p.m., an adult male contacted the Walnut Creek Police Dispatch Center using the police callbox outside of the main lobby of City Hall. The male stated to dispatch that he was having a mental health crisis and that he was in possession of a firearm.

Officers arrived on the scene almost immediately, and the male surrendered peacefully. There were no injuries, and the firearm was seized by officers. The male was detained for a mental health evaluation.
